



## V. Administrative Matters

- A. Review plans for commissioners and chiefs to attend the annual SAFE-D Conference in Round rock, Texas February 2-4, 2023:** Commissioner McCormack took a roll call of the commissioners and chiefs and determined that commissioners McCormack, Malone, Beer and Chief Escamilla were attending. McCormack said that he would register for the entire group.
- B. Update on the purchase of a squad car from the City of Ferris, Texas:** Chief Escamilla reported that the squad car purchase was completed and the squad car is now in service.

## VI. Operational Matters

- A. Receive Chief Wes Curry's Forreton VFD monthly report regarding emergency operations, response times, call volume, training, management activities and membership: (Some items may require action)** Chief Curry reported for the month of October, they had 9 runs, of which 3 were EMS assist, 3 dispatched & cancelled enroute, 3 motor vehicle accidents w/injuries.
- **Status of Forreton Rescue Grant:** Forreton VFD rescue grant for extrication tools will be completed by the deadline of April 12, 2023
  - **FY 2022-23 Forreton VFD budget Line-item transfer:** No action was required since the transfer in question was in the same budget category.
  - **Status of procuring emergency electrical generators for Forreton VFD and ECESD6 VFD:** Commissioner Howell moved to authorize Chief Curry to proceed with requests for proposal for two electrical generators, Commissioner Malone seconded, motion carried unanimously.
- B. Receive report from Chief Jake Escamilla on ESD#6 VFD and ECESD#6 regarding emergency operations, response times, call volume, training, management activities and membership including the following:** Chief Escamilla reported for the month of September, they had 53 calls, of which 33 were EMS, and 20 were fire related.
- **ISO review of the district** – Chief Escamilla reported that he is still waiting for Jeff Edwards to give us guidance on the rural water systems specifications that the district lacks for the ISO review.
  - **Consider revising the ECESD#6 Standard Operating Guidelines “Expense Reimbursement Request Form: for format and clarity:** Commissioner Johnston moved to approve the SOG-7 revision and Commissioner Malone seconded, motion passed unanimously.

**C. Set the date and time for the next ECESD#6 regular meeting.**

Without objection, Commissioner McCormack set the date for the District's next regular meeting to Monday, January 16, 2023, at 6:30 PM.

**VII. Comments from Commissioners on future District-related administrative or operational**
